Calcium Citrate (choose 1, if needed)

- After surgery, you need 1500-1800 mg calcium per day (for SADI procedures) or 1800-2400mg (DS/Type 1 Distalization procedures.)
- Talk to a dietitian about your calcium dose if eat a calcium rich diet. See our calcium guide <u>here</u>.
- Check the serving size to verify you are taking no more than 500-600mg per dose (the maximum your body can absorb at one time).
- Try to separate each dose of calcium by at least <u>4 hours</u> and separate calcium from multivitamins with iron, or iron supplements, by at least <u>2 hours</u>.
- Choose calcium CITRATE supplements, this is the easiest form of calcium to absorb and does not need to be taken with food.
