Dr. Susanne van Veluw is an Associate Professor in the department of Neurology at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) / Harvard Medical School. She obtained her PhD in Neuroscience at the University Medical Center Utrecht in the Netherlands, after which she moved to the US for her post-doctoral training at MGH with Steven Greenberg and Brian Bacskai.



Currently, her lab uses a range of translational neuroimaging techniques, including in vivo MRI in patients, ex vivo MRI-guided histopathology in human brain tissue, and in vivo two-photon microscopy in mice to study the pathophysiology of microvascular injury in cerebral amyloid angiopathy.
