Kenneth S. Kosik, M.A. M.D. served as professor at the Harvard Medical School from 1996-2004 when he became the Harriman Professor of Neuroscience and Co-Director of the Neuroscience Research Institute at the University of California Santa Barbara. He is a recipient of the Potamkin Prize and a fellow of the AAAS. He coauthored Outsmarting Alzheimer's Disease. His work in Colombia on familial Alzheimer's disease has appeared in the New York Times, BBC, CNN, PBS and CBS 60 Minutes.
